

## New Gen L200 (MY20)

### Tough(er) Show Cars

As part of L200's shift from "sleek" to "solid", Mitsubishi Motors has developed two show cars to further stress the radical new look its "Rock Solid" 6<sup>th</sup> generation pick-up truck.

First came a Rescue Vehicle, unveiled at the 2019 Geneva Motor Show – where L200 also made its European premiere.



Developed as a showcase for a 4WD mountain rescue vehicle, this white L200 is identified by its bold orange checkered side graphics, rescue utility markings (on front skid plate and black tailgate) and black alloy wheels.

A black roof rack with light bar, extending to the bed cover completes the set.

The bad cover itself is meant to suggest the power rescue equipment fitted beneath.

Then, a couple of weeks later, on March 26<sup>th</sup>, Mitsubishi Motors announced the "ABSOLUTE" show car, to be unveiled at the 40th Bangkok International Motor Show 2019.



For ABSOLUTE, Mitsubishi Motors designers have wished to exalt the extrovert, solid and rugged nature of the 6<sup>th</sup> generation L200.

Treated in black with metallic red accents and satin finish silver features, it plays with (higher) ground clearance, side body claddings, more substantial skid plates framing the truck front and rear, beefier wheels & tires fitted under sharply cut wheel arch extensions, a roof rack complete with dual light bar at the front and handles side & rear.

At the rear, ABSOLUTE comes with new heavy truck-inspired tailgate where the name “MITSUBISHI” is embossed across the width of the vehicle, itself surmounted by carbon fiber air dam extension.
